



Dr Nihad Fejzic - animal health economics and epidemiology specialist.

Nihad Fejzic is an animal health and epidemiology specialist with particular experience in terrestrial and aquatic disease surveillance and control, sanitary and phytosanitary measures and management of veterinary services. His area of expertise includes data analysis, system analysis, WTO, OIE and EU sanitary and phytosanitary measures and legislative framework, and international trade of animal products.

Dr Fejzic had studied veterinary medicine at University of Sarajevo (1986 – 1991) and hold PhD from animal health economics from same University. He had worked as assistant of Minister for agriculture in cantonal government (1996), deputy director of State veterinary office under Ministry of foreign trade and economics relations of BiH (2003 – 2007) and director of Agency for development of higher education and quality assurance of BiH under Council of Minister of BiH (2008-2011). Currently he is a professor at Veterinary faculty Sarajevo and from May 2012 he is on position of dean of this higher education institution.

Dr Fejzic was national coordinator for two FAO projects (genetic resources and aquatic animal health), local counterpart for EU twinning project with Germany as twinning partner (Support to state veterinary office), short term expert (trade, SPS, agriculture, animal by products) in several EU projects. Currently, he works as FAO international consultant on epidemiology and surveillance in Asia and Africa and as director of Interdisciplinary One health master study at University of Sarajevo.
