





2nd Congress The National School of Veterinary Medicine of Sidi Thabet Tunisia, October 25 – 26, 2018



The National School of Veterinary Medicine of Sidi Thabet is organizing its two-day second congress on October 25th and 26th, 2018 under the theme "The Veterinarian: an Actor in Sustainable Development" in the enclosure of the National School located in the region of Sidi Thabet, 20 km from the capital, Tunis.

Targeting the entire veterinary community, all scholars and professionals concerned with animal health issues and animal welfare, the congress proposes to the participants two major themes:

- 'Advances in canine and feline' under the slogan "Pet's Revolution" which meets the immediate requirements of all specializations (breeding, nutrition, biology, pathology, surgery, pharmacology, behavior and pet's care ...)
- 'Animal health management and product's quality as an opportunity for exchanges between scholars and professionals in different sectors of livestock and agro-food.

Apart from the mentioned-above themes, a session will be set aside to veterinary training in line with its socio-economic environment. We also aim to present to our partners the five-year strategic plan of the National School of Veterinary Medicine of Sidi Thabet.

A workshop will specifically focus on the dromedary by targeting its breeding and health issues through the participation of researchers and professionals.

This event will also give veterinarians and students the opportunity to express their creativity through an artistic and cultural exhibition that will be scheduled on the sidelines of the congress.
